Background

- High local unemployment Dual Economy
- Recruitment Problems Skills Shortage i.e Tourism Sector
- Benefit Pressure on the local economy -£3,500 per annum (IS)
- Socio-economic problems Psychological aspect





Equal Brighton & Hove

- £10.5 million part-European Social Fund/part-Brighton & Hove City Council funded programme
- Employment focus
- Action 2 delivery phase started in July 2005, ends December 2007
- 23 different projects, 70 different partners





Background to Equal

 Focuses on 11 socially excluded groups in the City — LGBT, BME, Ex Offenders, Ex Substance Misusers, Homeless, Deaf People, NEET 16 – 25, Deprived areas, Disabilities, Over 50s, Mental Health





Engage

- 45 agencies/organisations in the City working with target groups to get them into employment
- Offering advice & guidance
- Information on changes in employment legislation
- Matching right people to your business
